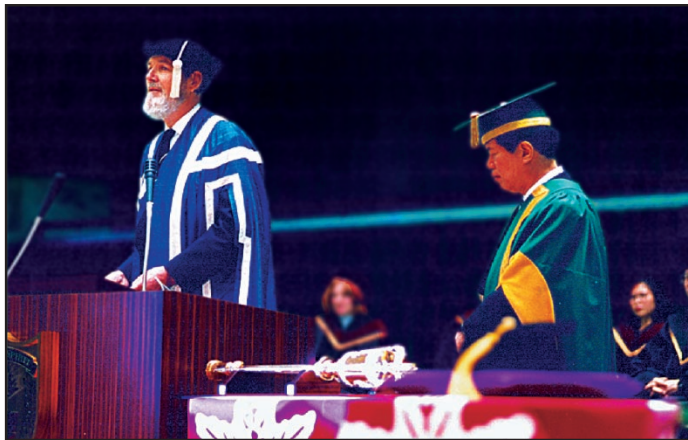


# Fattorini's University Maces Honour Academic Relations throughout the world.
